Who is eligible?

- Interested students will need to complete an application and participate in an intake interview with a parent/guardian.
- Priority will be given to students who demonstrate a need for an alternative academic environment, have completed 12 credits, and are a junior or senior.

What are the expectations of The Academy at Greenfield-Central?

- Students will attend either the morning (8:30-11:30) or afternoon (12:25-3:25) session. Due to the shortened day, students are required to provide their own transportation one way, either after the morning session or prior to the afternoon session.
- Attendance is mandatory. Students are required to be in attendance at The Academy at Greenfield-Central every day.
- Students will participate in job skills and community service opportunities as part of The Academy curriculum.
- Students may attend Walker Career Center or be employed 15 hours/week outside of their Academy schedule in order to earn elective credit.
- Students will still be Greenfield-Central High School students and will be allowed to participate in GCHS athletics and extracurricular activities, but will not be allowed into the high school unless previously arranged by The Academy director.
