1. Have your student go to the Technology office in the high school library. When students are there, they will receive a yellow sheet requesting the insurance.
2. One of Technology Resource Assistants will fill out the top part of the form. The TRA will also inspect the MacBook for any pre-existing defects.
3. After the inspection, students will bring home the yellow form for parent signature.
4. Payment will then be made in the Treasurer's office at the high school. Payment can be made by cash, check, or credit card. The yellow form **MUST** be brought to the Treasurer's office to make payment.
