The new Indiana Graduated Driver Licensing Law requires the student to be 15 years old before they can start any part of the Driver's Education program, including class time and drive time. Students will receive instruction at the first classroom/online session on how to obtain a Driver education permit. Students will be required to pass a written test at the BMV before the driving permit is issued.

Indiana state law requires each student to complete 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind-the-wheel in car instruction. In addition, Greenfield-Central High School provides students with in car observation time, up to 12 hours. Due to these specific time requirements, there are no tardies or excused absences.

Greenfield-Central will allow students to complete the classroom portion of the Driver's Education Program at Greenfield-Central High School <u>OR</u> online through the Central Indiana Educational Service Center (CIESC) Driver's Education Program. For student who choose the online course option, they will complete their driving with Greenfield-Central instructors in June during regular summer school.

• CLASS OPTION 1: GREENFIELD-CENTRAL CLASSROOM COURSE

- The Greenfield-Central High School spring semester classroom course will begin on TUESDAY, JANUARY 15, 2019.
 Classes will meet on TUESDAYS AND THURSDAYS from 3:40 5:40 p.m. at G-CHS. The class will finish on March 5, 2019. The fee for the G-C Classroom Course is \$55.00, payable to Greenfield-Central High School.
- The Greenfield-Central High School summer classroom course will begin **June 3, 2019.** Students who take the course at this time will be assigned in car instruction after completion of the 30 hours of required classroom time.
- CLASS OPTION 2: CENTRAL INDIANA EDUCATIONAL SERVICE CENTER ONLINE COURSE
 Students must register for the online course at http://driveredsafety.com/classrooms/driver-education-online. If you have questions, please contact CIESC at (317) 759-5560. The cost of the online course is \$55.00. Fees must be paid online when you register. Proof of successful completion is required prior to starting the G-C driving portion of the program.

IN CAR INSTRUCTION: The Greenfield-Central driving portion of the Driver's Education program will be offered in June during regular summer school hours. If your student is taking other summer school classes, please indicate that on the emergency form. (attached) It is the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian to avoid schedule conflicts with summer school. Due to the limited number of time slots, some requests cannot be honored. Students who successfully complete their classroom portion of the program will be given top priority in choosing drive times, if all fees are paid. **Course fees must be paid in full before scheduling in car instruction times.**

Summer School In car instruction time slots: Monday - Friday

FEES: The fee for the Driver's Education Program is \$365.00. The program fees must be paid in full by April 19, 2019. If a student completes the classroom portion with CIESC, the cost for the in car instruction portion will be \$310.00. Payment for the CIESC online classroom portion will be made directly to CIESC. The Driver's Education program fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE**. If the student does not comply with attendance and discipline requirements or withdraws from the Driver's Education program and/or school, **no refunds will be issued**.

Additional Details

Please consider the following when choosing which option for completing:

- 1. If you choose a classwork session with G-CHS, the class meets 15 times for 2 hours at a time. The school year class will meet from 3:40 5:40 PM on 2 evenings a week from the start date in January through the ending date in March. (exact dates to be determined). The summer class will meet from 1:00 3:00 PM, Monday through Friday for fifteen days (3 straight weeks) during the month of June. Students cannot miss any days in this class. There are no excused or unexcused absences. This is a commitment to the full 30 hours of training. Any emergency situations have to be worked out with the instructor.
- 2. If you choose the online option with Indiana Online Academy (IOA), there is a time limit on the completion of the class. If the student does not complete the course within the specified time frame, they will have to take the class again. Students will be charged for the class each time it is repeated through IOA.
- 3. If you choose the online option with Indiana Online Academy (IOA), classwork must be completed before the final regular drive day of the driving portion of the program.
- 4. When paying online for the IOA class, you may have to pay for both the driving and the classroom portions. If that occurs, CIESC will forward the payment for the driving portion to Greenfield-Central.

FYI: There are insurance companies that now give discounts on insurance if your student successfully completes a driver's ed course. Please check with your insurance company if your student is enrolled in this program.
