All students wishing to participate in the Senior Campout must agree to abide by the following rules:

- Must be a current senior at GCHS (No guests.)
- Students may check in between 9 p.m. and 11 p.m.
- Late arrival to the campout must be approved in advance with Mrs. Davenport.
- Upon arrival students must sign in and receive a wristband. Students will not be allowed to enter if they are not on the admission list. Students must wear their wristband the entire night.
- Upon arrival students will not be allowed to leave until Friday morning at 6:00 a.m.
- Students must be cleaned up and out of the stadium by 7:00 a.m.
- Students attending the campout are required to be at school on Friday, May 17 for the Senior Brunch at 10:00 a.m.
- Should a student need to leave due to illness, emergency, etc. a parent must come and pick them up.
- Students should bring their own camping supplies (tent, sleeping bag, etc.)
- Students may not set up tents on the football field and must use the designated areas.
- Males will set up their tents in the northeast corner of the stadium.
- Females will set up their tents in the southwest corner of the stadium.
- At no time are students allowed to be in the tent camping areas with members of the opposite sex.
- All school rules as listed in the Student Handbook will be enforced.
- Should any student violate any rules, school personnel will contact the parents/guardians to have them picked up and school disciplinary procedures will be followed.
- Students consent to a search of their possessions for illegal or dangerous items.
- Private security will be provided the entire night by the Greenfield Police Department.
