# Ivy Tech Dual Credit Course Transcripts

Any senior that has completed a dual credit Ivy Tech course with a passing grade of a "C" or better throughout your high school career, will need to have your Official Transcript transferred from Ivy Tech to the college or university you are attending.

Where can I find my Ivy Tech transcript, grades, and other important information?

Mylvy is Ivy Tech's online student portal. Students use Mylvy to get the latest news and announcements, access the online bookstore, check e-mail, view midterms and final grades, print unofficial transcripts and request official transcripts, find resources for the Technical Helpdesk, and more!

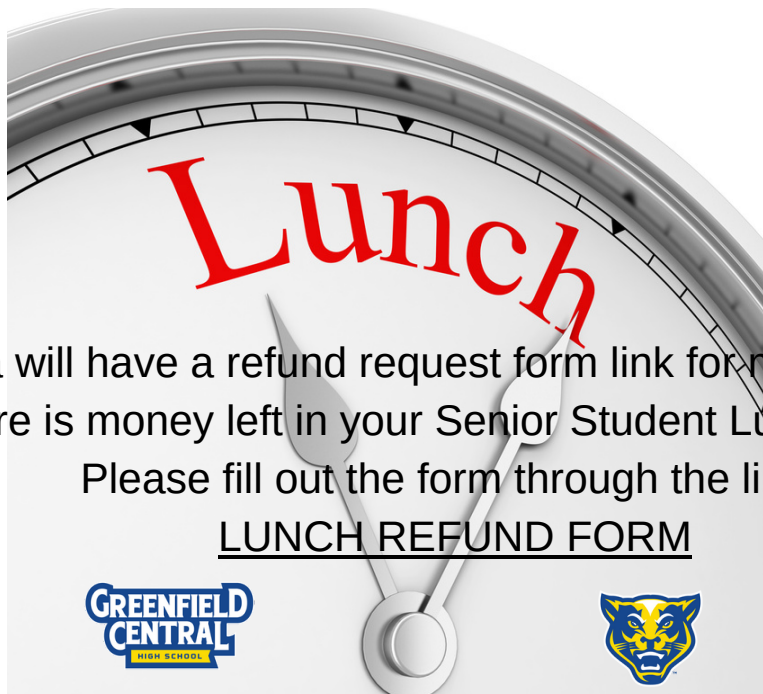
You can begin getting familiar with Mylvy before you even register for classes. To get started, follow the steps below:

1. Visit [myivy.ivytech.edu](http://myivy.ivytech.edu).
2. Scroll down and select the First Time User? option.
3. Your Ivy Tech e-mail address and Student ID number will be required when creating your account.
4. These can be found on your acceptance letter.
5. Follow the step-by-step instructions to activate your account. It is important to enter your name, birthdate, and zip code exactly as they appear on your admissions application.

## How do you order an Ivy Tech transcript?

Current students can request their Official transcript through Mylvy by taking the following steps:

- Step 1: Log into your Mylvy account ([myivy.ivytech.edu](http://myivy.ivytech.edu))
- Step 2: Click on Tools and Resources at the top of the form
- Step 3: Select Request Official Transcript from the list of items

All students wishing to participate in the Campout must agree to abide by the following rules:

- Must be a current senior at GCHS (No guests)
- Students may check in between 9PM and Midnight at the Fieldhouse
- Upon arrival students must sign in and receive a wristband. Students will not be allowed to enter if they are not on the admission list. Students must wear their wristband the entire night.
  - Students will not be dismissed to leave until Friday morning at 6AM
  - Students must be cleaned up and out of the stadium by 7AM
- Students attending the campout are expected to be at school on Friday, May 20th for the Senior Brunch beginning at 10:00AM
- Should a student need to leave due to illness, emergency, etc. a parent/legal guardian (as determined in PowerSchool) must come and pick them up.
  - Students should bring their own camping supplies (tent, sleeping bag, etc.)
- Students may not set up tents on the football field and must use the designated areas.
  - Males will set up their tents in the northeast corner of the stadium.
  - Females will set up their tents in the southwest corner of the stadium.
- At no time are students allowed to be in the tent camping areas with members of the opposite sex.
  - All school rules as listed in the Student Handbook will be enforced.
- Should any student violate any rules, school personnel will contact the parents/guardians to have them picked up; school disciplinary procedures will be followed.
  - Students consent to a search of their possessions for illegal or dangerous items.
  - Private security will be provided by the Greenfield Police Department.
